The Royal Three Counties Show Badge

Beavers must complete **all** of the following sections to earn this badge:

1. Attend **one day** at Royal Three Counties Show (15-17 June 2018).
2. Find our 'Meet the Groom' stand and ask a question to learn more about caring for horses.
3. Get involved with the Western Power interactive displays and pick up a free gift.
4. Watch the sheep shearing competition and witness the fastest and most skilful shearers in the country.
5. Visit the 'Ask the Farmer' marquee and learn a fact about rare breeds.
6. In preparation for ShireJam (hosted at Three Counties Showground on the 5-7th July 2019) decide within your group **one** activity idea that you would like to see happen there.

Cubs must complete **all** of the following sections to earn this badge.

1. Attend **one day** at Royal Three Counties Show (15-17 June 2018).
2. Watch one of the acts taking place in the **Main Arena**.
3. Head over to the Fur, Feather and Farm Area and complete the following:
 - a. Visit the Bees and Honey marquee and learn about wax and honey.
 - b. Learn two different types of poultry in the poultry marquee.
4. Watch the pole climbing competitions in the forestry area and time/record one of the races.
5. Get involved with the Western Power interactive displays and pick up a free gift.
6. Take a tour of the Heavy Horse Village with one of our stewards.
7. Visit 'The Rec Zone' and take part in activity on the Really Rural stand or Army stand.
8. In preparation for ShireJam (hosted at Three Counties Showground on the 5-7th July 2019) decide within your group **one** activity idea that you would like to see happen there.

Scouts must complete **all** of the following sections (1-6) to earn this badge and **two** options from section 7.

1. Attend **one day** at Royal Three Counties Show (15-17 June 2018).
2. Watch one of the acts taking place in the **Main Arena**.
3. Scouts must visit both of the following:
 - a. Watch the Farriery and Blacksmithing competitions in the Country Pursuits area. Learn about the history of farriery and blacksmithing.
 - b. Explore the lakeside area and take part in a rural activity.
4. Learn a new skill in the medieval camp.
5. Visit the Farming Village. Discuss what you learned about the animals you saw with your Patrol.
6. Find the 'Meet the Countryside' arena. Get a close up view of the animals and their owners. This is the perfect opportunity to ask how the animals are trained.
7. In preparation for ShireJam (hosted at Three Counties Showground on the 5-7th July 2019) decide within your group **one** activity idea that you would like to see happen there.
8. Scouts must choose **two** of the following options to complete:
 - a. Find the National Federation of Young Farmers Clubs marquee and learn about what they do/offer.
 - b. Get involved with the Western Power interactive displays and pick up a free gift.
 - c. Help the National Trust restore Elgar's piano by visiting their stand and learning about the historical figure.

Please note the badge criteria is subject to change.
